The Rotary Club of Scotts Valley Scholarship Program

The Rotary Club of Scotts Valley is the local chapter of the international Rotary service organization that focuses on community service. As part of our outreach, the Scotts Valley Rotary Club has had a long standing tradition of supporting the youth in the Scotts Valley community.

One of the programs available to students is the college scholarship program. This year we are awarding three (3) \$1,000 college scholarships to high school seniors. We are now seeking applicants for this year's scholarship awards.

The student requirements are as follows:

1. Must be a resident of the city of Scotts Valley
2. Minimum GPA of 3.0
3. Participation in at least one school-sponsored and one non-school extracurricular activity (e.g., sports, band, volunteer work, student council, newspaper, clubs)
4. Consideration is given to financial need, but need is not a requirement.

An application is considered complete if the following documents are submitted by the deadline announced each year.

1. A letter of interest from the student addressed to the Rotary Club of Scotts Valley. The letter should include information about college plans and goals, with a minimum of 250 words
2. A copy of the current high school transcript
3. A summary of awards, achievements, activities, and community involvement.
4. A statement regarding financial need, if that is a consideration.
