TIME COMMITMENTS

WEEKLY MEETINGS

Typically, there are 40 regular weekly club meetings per year. Unless otherwise noted as a special meeting, the club meets on Mondays at 12:15 at the Hilton in Scotts Valley. Members are expected to attend a minimum of 50% of the weekly meetings to maintain membership. However, meetings that are missed can be "made-up" at another club or online. Generally, a special event also counts as a make-up meeting.

COMMITTEE SERVICE

During the first year of membership, generally service on a committee will not be offered. However, as a Rotarian learns more about Rotary, service on a committee may be offered. Generally, committee service includes being a Board member.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

Annual Membership Dues..... 250.00 (may be paid monthly)
Weekly Detective Fines.....(Usually \$2 per meeting)

Should members want to purchase a meal or bottled drinks, there is a hotel charge. Members, however, are not required to purchase a meal or bottled drinks.

For fund raising and special events, members are expected to purchase tickets and either donate or help secure items for auction. However, the leadership of the club is sensitive to the fact that each person's financial situation is unique.
